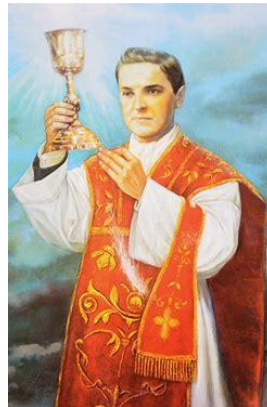

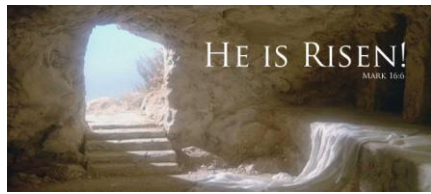
"Jesus is risen; God has given us eternal life in Jesus."

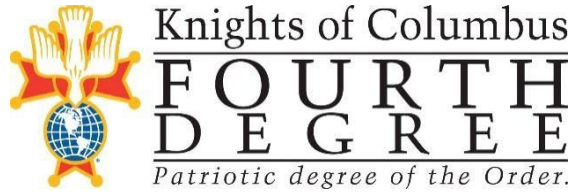

### ***The Flag and the Fourth Degree***

I pledge allegiance to the flag  
of the United States of America  
and to the Republic for which it stands, one  
nation under God, indivisible, with liberty  
and justice for all.

#### ***Did you Know?***

1. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States originated on Columbus Day, 1893. It contained no reference to Almighty God, until in New York City on April 22, 1954, the Board of Directors of the Knights of Columbus adopted a resolution to amend the Pledge of Allegiance as recited at the opening of each of the meetings of the 800 Fourth Degree Assemblies of the Knights of Columbus by addition of the words "(under God" after the words "one nation".

Flag Day, June 14, 1954" .. thereby making the official amendment conceived, sponsored and put into practice by the Knights of Columbus more than three years before. (adding Under God
