TO: Worthy District Deputies, District Marshals, Grand Knights, Financial Secretaries, Faithful Navigators and Faithful Comptrollers:

As the Master of John H. Reddin Province, District of New Mexico, I am pleased to announce that a Patriotic Exemplification will be held on **Saturday, January 25, 2020 in Grants, New Mexico**. Father Howard Meyer, OFM, Assembly 2218, and the exemplification and banquet occurring at the Knights Hall, 1601 Roosevelt Ave, Grants, NM 87020, host this exemplification. Mass will be held at St. Teresa of Avila Catholic Church, 500 W. High St., Grants, NM 87020. All 3rd Degree Knights in good standing seeking to attain their Fourth and final Degree and reach full Knighthood in our Order are invited to register to attend this exemplification ceremony.

Form 4.

- The key to a 3rd Degree Brother Knight becoming a Sir Knight starts with the detailed completion and timely submission of his Form 4, Fourth Degree Membership Document
- Check that all boxes in the form are completed and all signatures appear on the form.
- The proposer will take the candidate's Form 4 to his assembly meeting. The membership will vote on the candidate for acceptance into the assembly.
- You will then submit the Form 4 and the Registration Form below to me with a check for the registration fee of \$70.00 (fee includes the cost of the candidate's Fourth Degree emblem pin and the banquet). The cost for spouse and guest(s) attending the banquet is \$25.00 per person.
- **Remember to mail the Form 4, the Application, and a check by United States Postal Service (USPS) – leave the completed Form 4 intact, as the District Master must endorse all four copies.**

Exemplification Attire.

- The attire that Patriotic Degree candidates wear to Exemplifications was changed last year by Supreme.
- The requirement of candidates to acquire a black tuxedo for wear at the Patriotic exemplification is no longer in effect.
- **Wearing of a black, navy blue or dark gray business suit (no sport coat) with long-sleeve, white dress shirt, long necktie or bow tie, black shoes and socks is now the basic dress required to become a Sir Knight.**
- Once you become a Sir Knight, you will then have the option to purchase the official uniform of the Fourth Degree – Navy blue blazer with the 4th Degree emblem, gray trousers, Fourth Degree necktie, and black beret with the 4th Degree badge. The member provides plain-collar, long-sleeve white dress shirt (no button-down collar or French cuffs), black shoes and socks.

Color Corps:

- Acquiring the Fourth Degree uniform is necessary in order to become a member of your assembly's Color Corps and thus be able to participate in honor guards and color guards.
- Inclusion of the current Knights of Columbus sword, scabbard and service baldric along with white gloves completes the ensemble for Color Corps members.

The colored chapeaus with feathers, color-lined capes and social baldric is not be authorized after June 30, 2019.

Candidates who are currently serving in the Armed Forces, are a full-time police officer or firefighter are in proper attire when wearing his Class A-equivalent dress uniform – no BDUs, fatigues, flight suits, tactical gear.
