TO: Worthy District Deputies, District Marshals, Grand Knights, Financial Secretaries, Faithful Navigators and Faithful Comptrollers:

As the Master of John H. Reddin Province, District of New Mexico, I am pleased to announce that a Patriotic Exemplification will be held on **Saturday, May 15, 2021 at St Jude Thaddeus Parish, Fr. John Conway Center, Albuquerque, New Mexico and Virtually**. All 3rd Degree Knights in good standing seeking to attain their Fourth and final Degree and reach full Knighthood in our Order are invited to register to attend this exemplification ceremony.

Form 4.

- **The key to a 3rd Degree Brother Knight becoming a Sir Knight starts with the detailed completion and timely submission of his Form 4, Fourth Degree Membership Document.**
- **Check that all boxes in the form are completed and all signatures appear on the form.**
- **The proposer will take the candidate's Form 4 to his assembly meeting. The membership will vote on the candidate for acceptance into the assembly.**
- You will then submit the Form 4 and the Registration Form below to me with a check for the registration fee of \$50.00 (fee includes the cost of the candidate's Fourth Degree emblem pin baldric and fees to Supreme). Due to the current COVID Restrictions there is no banquet being prepared at this time.
- **Remember to mail the completed Form 4, the Application, and a check by United States Postal Service (USPS) – leave the completed Form 4 intact, as the District Master must endorse all four copies.**

Exemplification Attire.

- **Wearing of a black, navy blue or dark gray business suit with long-sleeve, white dress shirt, long necktie or bow tie, black shoes and socks is now the basic dress required to become a Sir Knight. ****Currently due to COVID 19 safety criteria a face mask will be required for anyone able to show for the in-person Exemplification******
- Once you become a Sir Knight, you will then have the option to purchase the official uniform of the Fourth Degree – Navy blue blazer with the 4th Degree emblem, gray trousers, Fourth Degree necktie, and black beret with the 4th Degree badge. The member provides plain-collar, long-sleeve white dress shirt (no button-down collar or French cuffs), black shoes and socks.

Color Corps:

- Acquiring the Fourth Degree uniform is necessary in order to become a member of your assembly's Color Corps and thus be able to participate in honor guards and color guards.
- Inclusion of the current Knights of Columbus sword, scabbard and service baldric along with white gloves completes the ensemble for Color Corps members.

Candidates who are actively serving in the Armed Forces, are a full-time police officer or firefighter are in proper attire when wearing his Service-equivalent dress uniform – no BDUs, fatigues, flight suits, tactical gear or Mess Dress.
