The modified requirements to earn the Star Assembly Award and their current status are:

* Earn the Fourth Degree Civic award **(submitted May 31)**

Current activities for the award are:

- Veterans recognition activity
- Keep the flag at the Our Lady of Annunciation Parish Rectory at the proper staff position
- Provide a \$300 donation to the food pantry for the New Mexico Fisher House whose **purpose is to support America's veterans in their time of need by providing a "home away from home" that enables families to be close during their hospitalization**
- Working with the Our Lady of the Annunciation Parish Office and attending voter registration training in order to hold a voter registration drive at the Parish following weekend Masses

* Enter the "to be a patriot" competition **(provided to the District Master this week for the U.S. Flag Retirement and Veteran's Recognition Project)**

* Meeting the assembly new membership goal of 7% – reduced by 40% per the Supreme Master – modified goal for the Assembly is two (2) new members **(not yet completed – depends on the conduct of a Fourth Degree Exemplification this fraternal year¹)**

* Submit the report of officers 186 due July 1st **(submitted May 12, 2020 through Member Management)**

* Submit the annual survey of fraternal activity 1728 due January 31st **(submitted)**

* Submit the annual assembly audit report 1315 **(completed for the 2018-2019 Fraternal Year, due for the 2019-2020 Fraternal Year by August 1)**

* Publish a monthly newsletter or bulletin for assembly members – this requirement was reduced to publishing a monthly newsletter from July 2019 to February 2020 **(completed)**

The first Color Corps request came out on May 29 for a rosary and funeral at Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish on June 1. If you wish to participate in a Color Corps activity remember you need to have a black mask to go with your regalia.
